



Guide on safeguarding your credit card

- Sign your credit card immediately after receiving it
- Do not let anyone else use your credit card
- Do not provide your credit card details to an unknown party as they may use it to make purchases via telephone, mail or the Internet
- Make sure you cut your expired credit card after getting a new one to prevent it from being cloned or tampered with
- Check all details on the charge slips before signing
- Keep all your charge slips and check it against your credit card statement when you receive it
- Keep your credit card in the same place in your wallet or purse so that you will notice immediately if it is lost or stolen
- Report lost, stolen cards or unauthorised transactions to your card issuer immediately. If you do not report the loss, you are liable for all transactions posted to your card until it is reported!
